

INTERNATIONAL NETWORK OF EMC LABORATORIES (FOR-EMC) AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by Institute of Logistics and Warehousing established under Polish laws (hereinafter **COORDINATOR**), having its principle office at E. Estkowskiego 6, 61-755 Poznań, Poland; and

(hereinafter **MEMBER**), having its principle office at _____

WHEREAS, **FOR-EMC** is a network whose mission is:

- acting for conformity assessment within the 89/336/EEC Directive and its new edition,
- technical actions supporting European Commission policy resulting from New Approach Directives,
- setting up and the maintenance of co-ordination and co-operation to enable equivalence of interpretation regarding conformity assessment of apparatus throughout the EU,
- identification and resolving of any problems and interpretation of the conformity assessments,
- consolidation the efforts of the EMC (electromagnetic compatibility) laboratories on a European scale,
- supporting the most efficient use of their resources,
- common participation in EU Framework Programmes,
- working on other common ventures within the EMC,
- creating working groups on specific EMC issues,
- delivering information about EMC law in particular countries
- mutual conduction of professional trainings.

WHEREAS, the Parties are collaborating and continue to collaborate on the foregoing; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and the mutual benefits, the Parties agree as follows:

ARTICLE I. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT.

This agreement states the entire contract between the parties as of the date of final signature below in respect to the subject matter of the agreement and supersedes any previous written or oral representations, statements, negotiations, or agreements. This agreement may be modified only by written amendment executed by the authorized representatives of both parties.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF THE WORK.

Member agrees to participate in the International Network of EMC Laboratories – FOR-EMC.

ARTICLE III. PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE.

The period of performance of this agreement is indefinitely, unless terminated in accordance with Article VIII.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP FEE.

The annual membership fee is 350 EUR, converted proportionally to the average monthly gross wage and salary in national economy of the MEMBER country. **There is no fee within the first year of the membership** – all administrative, etc., costs will be covered by COORDINATOR.

ARTICLE VI. MEETINGS.

The FOR-EMC Network shall organize at least one occasion during each year of the association's existence. All members are invited to participate and organizing (at one's own expense) meetings. Meetings may be connected with other events (fairs, workshops, etc.).

ARTICLE VII. RECORD RETENTION

Financial records, supporting documents, and other record pertaining to this agreement shall be maintained and retained by COORDINATOR for a period of one year from the termination of this agreement.

ARTICLE VIII. TERMINATION

Either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty (30) days advance written notice to the other party.
